 - Never, under any circumstances swim under any obstacles, always go over the top surface.
 - Never jump from module to module or from height onto a module, they are hard and could cause injury.
 - Never dive head first into the water, you must always enter feet first.
 - Always look up when climbing. Do not climb underneath someone climbing above you. People can slip and fall whilst climbing.
 - Make sure the water and landing area is clear of all people before jumping or sliding in the water.
 - If sliding, do not hold hands, slide separately. Do not slide down areas with handles attached.
 - No pushing or excessively rough play, smaller children should be given right of way.
 - Always follow the directions of staff on duty
 - The park must never be used under the influence of alcohol or drugs, furthermore, it is only for use during public opening hours when staff are on duty.
